Background: The International Coalition to Ban Uranium Weapons has been committed for years to a ban on uranium weapons use as a particularly abhorrent form of environmental destruction caused by war. The work is embedded in the broader context of toxic wartime consequences (such as caused by Agent Orange), "Toxic remnants of war" (www.toxicremnantsofwar.info).

Tasks and requirements:
